2021 CORPORATE RESPONSIBILITY REPORT

On December 17, 2021, we announced our climate ambition, which includes our goal to reach net-zero Scope 1, 2 and certain direct Scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, aligned with the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) and its new Net-Zero Standard. We also announced our commitment to achieve near-term science-based targets by 2030, including reducing Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 46% and certain direct Scope 3 emissions by 28%, as compared to 2019. We will include and report our progress to these goals in future reports.
